equipment list and will be working toward ordering the equipment. We have ordered some of the equipment and some is currently being delivered.

2021 AFG Grant

We were fortunate that they extended the grant application deadline to January 21, 2022. I submitted the application for a new fire engine to replace Engine 1 with an amount of \$375,000. Our cost share if awarded is \$17,857.14. The application was submitted on January 18, 2022. **Waiting on award announcement. Possibly starting announcements next month.**

Hannahville Grant

We put in a grant for some mechanic tools for the station. Received notification we were awarded the grant. **Will start ordering the tools.**
